Kirkbride is a village and civil parish in Cumbria it was historically part of Cumberland. Langlands Head and Powhil are hamlets within the parish. The church of St. Bride, or Brydock, is a small ancient structure, said to have been erected before the Norman accession. The only other place of worship here was a meeting-house for the Society of Friends.
